Happy New Year! We hope that you all had a very merry Christmas!










Firstly, we would like to say a HUGE thank you for your generosity for the gifts at Christmas - you are always so kind and thoughtful - thank you very much!

Our theme for the term is 'Crisis and Change.' Our first half term's work will be mainly based on the amazing book 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' by Onjali Q. Rauf. This will provide us with many different writing opportunities, as well as a wealth of learning about refugees, empathy and change. We will also be focusing on place knowledge and land use in geography, comparing our setting with another European country. We are also lucky enough to be going to Chichester Festival Theatre to see the production of The Boy at the Back of the Class on Thursday 29th February.





Monday 29th January is our exciting trip to the O2 to take part in Young Voices 2024.

Then after half term, we will change our focus to history and science by looking at Titanic and Forces.



Please continue to encourage your child to read regularly at home. Pupils should record details of their reading in their Homework Diary. We expect at least 3 reads per week (ideally, for at least 20 minutes) and one of these reads will be to an adult. Diaries will be checked each Friday and each read is worth a house point.



Spelling homework will be set each Monday and should be completed and handed in by the following Monday. Details of spelling homework will be available on our Google classroom.

Mathematics homework will be set each **Friday** and should be completed and handed in by the following Tuesday.
